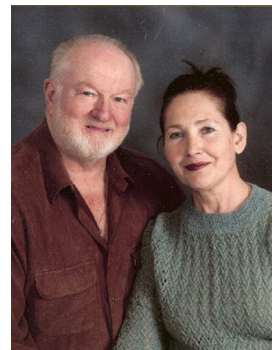

When he was seventeen, his parents moved to Dawes Co., Nebraska, while he stayed in Iowa. He taught school for one year in Cass Co., Iowa, and then he attended business school at Davenport, Iowa, before moving to Nebraska. He taught school for two years in Dawes Co., and served one year as county superintendent of Dawes Co. He then taught school two years at Hemingford, NE, and while he was there, he met Fannie Gerber [d May 1972 at Burwell, NE].^a They were married 13 June 1896 at Hemingford. Leonard served as a family manager at the Boys Industrial School at Kearney for four years.

Leonard and Fannie moved to a ranch north of Burwell in 1901, which was part of what is now the Gaylord Wallace ranch, and they lived there two and a half years. In 1903, they moved to Burwell. Leonard began a partnership with C.I. Bragg until Mr. Bragg's passing, and he continued the business of abstracting, real estate, insurance, and collections. He served two years overseas as a Red Cross worker during World War I, served as county judge of Garfield Co., was police judge of Burwell, and he served several years as county Red Cross chairman.

Leonard retired from active business in 1953. He was preceded in death by his parents and three sisters. Left to mourn his passing were his devoted wife, Fannie; one brother, Bradford Fenner of Larkspur, CA; and one sister, Mrs. Bettie Bartlett, of Chadron, NE. No children.
